The ordinary Degree requirements are 40 courses, including the completion of the number of courses specified by the major with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0, along with the satisfaction of the General Education Requirement. For the purpose of fulfilling curricular requirements, a course is any semester unit to which a value of three credits or more is assigned. A laboratory associated with a course is not considered as a separate course, even when it carries a separate course number and grade.
