

**THE FIVE-YEAR COMBINED B.S./M.S. IN EDUCATION WITH CERTIFICATIONS IN  
ELEMENTARY EDUCATION, SPECIAL EDUCATION, AND READING**

Saint Joseph's University's combined B.S./M.S. program in Education offers students an opportunity to complete two degree programs while gaining three certifications in their five years of study: Elementary Education, Special Education, and Reading Specialist. During the summer of the fifth year, students will teach in the University's summer Reading Center, working with students identified as reading and learning disabled. To be eligible for the five-year program, students must have a 3.0 GPA. 37.5% scholarships are available for "day" students.
