Applications for undergraduate Fellows are now being accepted. Any student majoring in Biology, Environmental Science, Physics, or Chemistry is eligible to apply; the ideal applicant will be a sophomore or junior involved in undergraduate research and interested in continuing research during the summer of 2006. Undergraduate Fellows are expected to commit 5-10 hrs per week to their GK-12 duties. During the summer, they spend the balance of their time working on research projects with their faculty mentors. Stipends are \$10 per hour for the academic year and up to \$5000 for the following summer. Applications must be delivered by November 10, 2005, to insure consideration for the 2006 spring semester.
