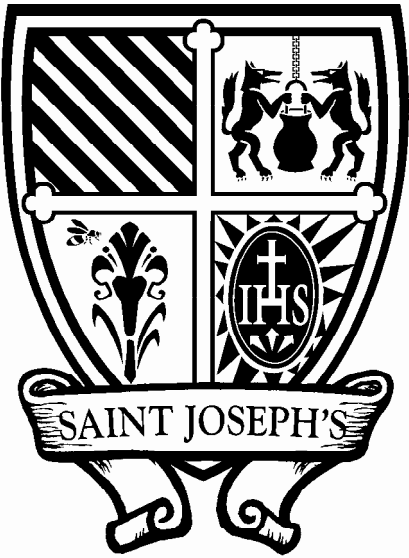

In the 148-year history of Saint Joseph's University, 23 different persons have held the office of president, serving for an average of six years. Two of the presidents served two terms - Felix Barbelin, S.J. (first and fourth) and Cornelius Gillespie, S.J. (eighth and tenth). The fifth president, Burchard Villager, S.J., served for the longest period, 25 years.
