## BILL

### Amendment for At Large Senators

1 Whereas the Saint Joseph's University Student Senate received and acted upon the  
2 following in due course and proper procedure the following bill, and as such, passed  
3 with a clearly plural majority this expression of the resolution:

5 Whereas the University Student Senate should strive to be as representative of the  
6 student body of Saint Joseph's University as possible.  
7

8 Whereas the student body of Saint Joseph's is constantly evolving and changing.  
9

10 Whereas the University Student Senate should strive to mirror the University's goal  
11 to become the preminent institution of its kind in the Northeast and engage the  
12 student body in the same.  
13

14 Whereas the Constitution of the University Student Senate provides for the  
15 appointment of at-large senators to the Administrative Board in order to further  
16 represent the student body in a more comprehensive manner.  
17

18 Whereas it is the responsibility of the Student Body President to strive to make the  
19 Student Senate more able to and more efficient in serving the student body.  
20

21 Whereas a limited number of at-large senator appointments would prohibit the  
22 Student Senate from comprehensively and effectively representing the evolving  
23 student body.

25 Now, therefore, be it ACTED that Article V, Section B, Part 2, Section B of the  
26 University Student Senate Constitution be amended to say that the Student Body  
27 President will have the power to nominate three to six at-large senators to be  
28 approved by the elected University Student Senate Administrative Board.
