## RESOLUTION

### The Resolution Resolution

1 Whereas the Saint Joseph's University Student Senate received and acted upon the  
2 following in due course and proper procedure the following resolution, and as such,  
3 passed with a clearly plural majority this expression of the resolution:

5 Whereas it is necessary to pass by majority vote resolutions in order to express the  
6 official position and intent of the Senate regarding University policy, the concerns  
7 and interests of the student body, the functioning of the Senate, and all other matters  
8 of import to student governance.

10 Whereas historically there has been an insignificant amount of legislation passed by  
11 Senate and a failure to accurately convey the Senate's position and intent on the  
12 aforementioned matters.

14 Whereas it is in the interest of the Senate to pass more legislation in order to  
15 publicize our concerns, opinions, and projects to the students whom we are  
16 representing and to advertise our goals and subsequently our progress towards their  
17 completion.

19 Now, therefore, be it RESOLVED that the members of the University Student  
20 Senate strive to pass a resolution for all ideas, opinions, concerns, theories, goals,  
21 projects, hopes, and decisions that they hold and devise.
