RESOLUTION

Staying In Touch Resolution

1 Whereas the Saint Joseph's University Student Senate received and acted upon the
2 following in due course and proper procedure the following resolution, and as such,
3 passed with a clearly plural majority this expression of the resolution:

5 Whereas the Student Body President is the elected representative of the entire
6 student body, serving as both a ceremonial head and as a chief liaison for all matters
7 pertaining to students to the administration.

9 Whereas it is necessary that the Student Body President, as per required by the
10 position, maintain an active communication with the students of Saint Joseph's
11 University in order so that they may be aware of the Student President's performance
12 and progress on stated goals and his adeptness in striving to have the student voice
13 heard in administrative matters.

15 Whereas there are a number of student organizations at Saint Joseph's University
16 that act as media outlets for the reporting and expression of student issues and
17 opinions.

19 Now, therefore, be it RESOLVED that the Student Body President utilizes such
20 outlets as the Hawk newspaper, the student radio station WSJR, and other creative
21 means of communications at least on a regular basis in order to keep the student body
22 informed on all aforementioned matters.
